Abstract	A brief summary of the contents of your document/file.				
Authors /editor	The individual(s) or organisation(s) responsible for the creation, editing, contributing, etc. to the document. Add the appropriate role.	Robert Plant Jimmy Page John Bonham			
Page Count	Add the number of pages within the document.				
Date Published	The date when the document was 'published'. This can be a physical publication date or a date when the document was produced in its digital form.	01/Jan/2012			
Publisher	The 'publisher' of the document. This can be an actual publisher, or the organisation responsible for producing the document.	Wessex Archaeology			
Place Published	The place of publication, or the location of the organisation, responsible for producing the document.	Salisbury			
Volume / Issue/ Report Number	Any volume, issue and report numbers associated with report or document.				
ISBN	Does the file have an ISBN (International Standard Book Number)? If it does then you should record the number here.	978-3-16-148410-0			
ISBN	This should be a 10 or 13 digit numeric code. N.B. Please include the (-) separator in the number.
